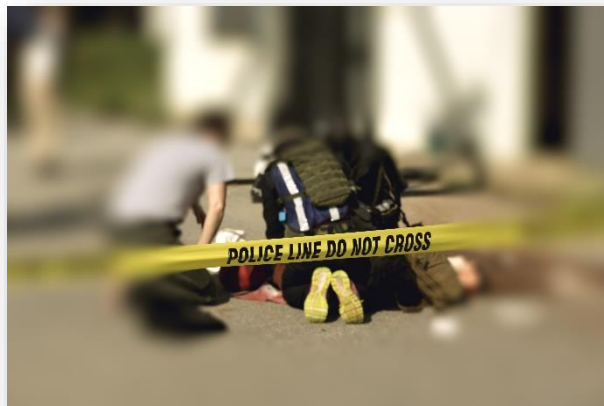




Active Armed Offender (Active Shooter)

An armed offender is an individual who is actively engaged in killing, attempting, or threatening to kill people, and who has demonstrated their intention to continue to do so. This session is designed to equip staff with the knowledge and skills to safely deal with an Active Armed Offender situation. It includes:

- Awareness of potential threat situations
- How to respond when an Active Armed Offender is in your vicinity
- How to respond when emergency services arrive
- How to create an Emergency Action Plan
- Leadership within an Active Armed Offender situation
- Behavioural Analysis skills
- Mantra "Run Hide Tell"
- The Australia and New Zealand Counter Terrorist Committee Guidelines



The New Zealand context.

According to the government, New Zealand's threat level sits at medium - a terrorist attack is assessed as feasible and could well occur. We have already seen this with the Christchurch Mosque shootings, devastatingly proving that nowhere is safe. Guidelines supported by the government advise that places where crowds may gather are particularly prone to these attacks. They include:

- Sporting, tourism, entertainment venues and major events
- Shopping and business precincts
- Government buildings
- Educational facilities
- Places of worship
- Hotels and convention centres
- Public transport hubs
