



## **C4 CERTIFICATE IN SECURITY CONSULTANCY (BASIC)**

Consultant's working or intending to work in the New Zealand security industry are required to hold a licence under the Private Security Personnel and Private Investigators Act 2010. The C4 Certificate in Security Consultancy (Basic) is designed to provide an introduction to the role of Security Consultant and enable graduates to apply for a Certificate of Approval in that category. This certificate is non-NZQA, but it prepares learners for the C4 Certificate in Security Consultancy (Advanced) and will ultimately lead to the New Zealand Diploma in Security Level 6 (Security Consultancy).

A Security Consultant is employed as an advisor and supervisor for all security measures necessary to protect a client's assets. This covers a wide range of security related tasks, including the protection of property, financial assets, information, valuable objects, and people.

Security Consultants use their knowledge and expertise to assess possible security threats and breaches to prevent them from happening. They also develop contingency protocols and plans when violations do occur.

### **What does this course include?**

Designed to be completed over a six month period, the C4 Certificate in Security Consultancy consists of five modules that cover some of the more important aspects of basic security consultancy including:

- Risk Assessment
- Security Surveys
- Security Legislation and Compliance
- Operational Security planning
- Policy and Procedures
