



TERRORISM AWARENESS/CROWDED PLACES SAFETY

While we think of terrorism as something that happens overseas, the tragic events in Christchurch show us that we are not immune. This highlights the need for businesses, organisations, communities, religious groups, and individuals to take steps to better prepare themselves for an event of this nature. Our course provides essential knowledge and practical skills aimed at supporting your staff specifically, and our community at large.

What is terrorism?

Terrorism is the use of force or violence against persons or property in violation of criminal laws for purposes of intimidation, coercion, or ransom. It threatens the security of nations, communities, and individuals. Activation of these threats has brought about large-scale loss of life, the destruction of property, widespread illness and injury, the displacement of large numbers of people, and devastating economic losses. Acts of terrorism follow a predictable and consistent path from conception to execution. Although the terrorists have a definite advantage, they do have weaknesses that can be exploited. If we are aware of these weaknesses, we can use them to our advantage and possibly prevent an attack, or at least be more prepared to react in the event that it does occur.
